RESOLUTION NO. 26-1

Land And Water Conservation Fund (LWCF) Grant Application

WHEREAS, the United States of America and the State of South Dakota have authorized the making of grants from the Land and Water Conservation Fund (LWCF) to public bodies to aid in financing the acquisition and/ or construction of specific outdoor recreation projects;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. The Chairperson of Hayti is hereby authorized to execute and file an application on behalf of the Town of Hayti with the National Park Service, U.S. Department of the Interior, through the State of South Dakota, Department of Game, Fish and Parks, Division of Parks and Recreation, for an LWCF grant to aid in financing playground equipment for the Town of Hayti, South Dakota, and its Environs.
2. That Debra Goebel, Chairperson of Hayti, is hereby authorized and directed to furnish such information as the above-mentioned federal and/or state agencies may reasonably request in connection with the application which is hereby authorized to be filed.
3. That the Town of Hayti shall provide a minimum of 50% of the total cost of the project; and will assume all responsibility in the operation and maintenance of the project upon completion of construction, for the reasonable life expectancy of the facility.
