The Board of Trustees, of the Town of Hayti, South Dakota, met on Mon., Dec. 15, 6:30 p.m. at the City Office. Members present were Debra Goebel, Jeremy Struckman, Dylan Reuer, and Jeremiah Gramberg. Absent: Cody Swenson.

Chairwoman Debra Goebel called the meeting to order.

The Pledge of Allegiance was said.

Struckman made a motion to approve the agenda, seconded by Gramberg. All voted in favor, motion passed.

2<sup>nd</sup> Reading Ordinance #338 – 2025 Supplemental Appropriation Ordinance was held.

Gramberg made a motion to approve Ordinance #338, seconded by Reuer. All voted in favor, motion passed.

2<sup>nd</sup> Reading Ordinance #339 –Amend Ord. #103 Set Water/Sewer Rates by Resolution was held. Reuer made a motion to approve Ordinance #339, seconded by Gramberg. All voted in favor, motion passed.

Motion by Struckman to approve Resolution 25-2 A Resolution Establishing Revised Water Rates, seconded by Reuer. All voted in favor, motion passed.

**RESOLUTION 25-2**

**A Resolution Establishing Revised Water Rates**

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Hayti is responsible for providing safe, reliable, and sustainable water service to its customers; and

**WHEREAS**, the costs of securing, treating, and delivering water, as well as maintaining and upgrading the water system infrastructure, have increased due to the supplier, Sioux Rural Water, raising rates; and

**WHEREAS**, the current water rates are insufficient to cover the full cost of operations, maintenance, and long-term system investments;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Town of Hayti that:

**Effective Date** – The revised water rates shall take effect on January 1, 2026.

**Rate Adjustment** – The Base Water rate shall be increased by \$5 per month, from \$25 to \$30 a month.

**Purpose** – Revenue from the rate increase shall be used exclusively for water system operations, maintenance, debt service, and capital improvements.

**PASSED AND ADOPTED** this 15th of December, 2025, by the Hayti Board of Trustees of Hayti, South Dakota, Hamlin County.

There being no further business, motion by Reuer; seconded by Struckman to adjourn. All voted in favor, the meeting adjourned.
