

**ORDINANCE NO. 250**  
**AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE USE AND/OR SALE**  
**OF FIREWORKS**

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Hayti, South Dakota:

**Section I      Definition**

The term fireworks as referred to in this Ordinance shall include firecrackers, sky rockets, roman candles, blank cartridges, or other pyrotechnic displays, but shall not include or apply to ammunition for firearms nor to dynamite and devices for exploding the same used in any industry or for the same, and not used or kept for public display.

**Section II**

It shall be unlawful for any person to sell, use, explode, set off or fire any fireworks described in Section I hereof, except on July Fourth of each year, or, in the event July Fourth falls on a Sunday, then on a day locally accepted by common consent for observance of the holiday.

**Section III**

Any person, firm or corporation, by agent or otherwise, violating the provision of this ordinance, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by fine in an amount not to exceed \$100.

**Section IV      Repeal**

All ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
